### Utah Population Estimates Committee

#### MISSION

The Utah Population Estimates Committee prepares the official population estimates for the State of Utah and provides feedback to the Governor's Office of Planning and Budget on population issues. Specifically, the committee:

- Prepares and publishes annual mid-year population estimates for the state, multi-county districts, and counties;
- Prepares municipal population estimates for funds- distribution if: (a) the Bureau of the Census discontinues production of postcensal estimates at the subcounty level; (2) a new municipality is incorporated; or (3) a municipality incorporates an area which includes significant additional population and requests revised estimates.
- Advises the Governor's Office of Planning and Budget on Bureau of the Census estimates and programs, and assists with the State Data and Business and Industry Data Center Programs, the Federal-State Cooperative for Population Estimates, and the national decennial census; and
- Documents and reports methodologies and activities used in estimating.
